Today in worship we continue our message series, **“Won’t You Be My Neighbor?”**. Jesus teaches that neighbors care in real, practical ways that restore wholeness, promote justice and mercy, and foster dignity for all. One of our 4D Vision “big ideas” expresses our commitment to reconciliation and bridge-building in our church, our community, and our world as an expression of the reconciliation we know in Christ and in recognition of the diverse beauty of God’s creation. In this series, we will explore what it means to be a good neighbor in a culture that is often characterized by division. How can we be instruments of healing and reconciliation across the barriers that divide us? Today we will acknowledge that while we have come a long way, the reality of racial division still exists and we have a responsibility to be instruments of healing and grace in that division. We will use Ephesians 2:11-22 to reflect on the power of Christ to help us dismantle the walls of racial division and find healing and reconciliation with our neighbors.
