#### **Mission Moments**

**Mission Boxes** for January are for Daily Bread in downtown Melbourne, which provides meals and shelter for the hungry and homeless. Daily Bread also supports and assists with healthcare, case management, employment, transitional and social support services. Their goal is to help individuals to become self-sufficient. Mission Boxes collected \$1,171.52 for Cuba in December.

Jesus teaches that neighbors care in real, practical ways that restore wholeness, promote justice and mercy, and foster dignity for all. One of our 4D Vision "big ideas" expresses our commitment to reconciliation and bridge-building in our church, our community and our world as an expression of the reconciliation we know in Christ and in recognition of the diverse beauty of God's creation. In this series, we will explore what it means to be a good neighbor in a culture that is often characterized by division. How can we be instruments of healing and reconciliation across the barriers that divide us? Today we will reflect on our call as ambassadors for Christ in the ministry of reconciliation described in II Corinthians 5:16-20, and on the vision of community found in the prophets and espoused by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
